Glasgow's tech ecosystem has many of the expected ingredients including its renowned higher and further education institutions providing talent, research and innovation.




Funding report:
Venture Capital (VC) in the Glasgow City Region

Q1 2023 has been Glasgow City Region's third highest quarter on record for VC investment, driven by Healthtech Phlo, DxCover, Causeway Therapeutics and PneumoWave rounds.

Early to mid-stage funding has been strong over the past three years, reaching an all time high in 2021 of £115M, with this year showcasing a similar strong start for funding.



Round proportions for Glasgow VC investments









2. The Glasgow City Region Ecosystem in greater depth

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
The Glasgow Tech Ecosystem has entered a virtuous cycle.




Although Glasgow has untapped potential, efforts to drive entrepreneurship, learn from benchmarks like Waterloo, Ontario, and foster closer ties within the accelerator community show promising progress.

Research at city regional universities have led to the creation of 100+ spinouts. Hundreds of university alumni have turned to entrepreneurship, creating value locally and internationally.


Glasgow's perception as a startup city has gradually changed, although it was not initially recognized despite its large number of tech professionals in the financial services sector.





Main Investor source location for investors into Glasgow 2018-2022












Foreign investors have invested over £90M into Glasgow City Region startups since 2017, a rapidly growing trend since 2019

4. Glasgow in international perspective

Glasgow City Region is within a 2 hour travel radius of the UK and Europe's leading ecosystems

The Glasgow metropolitan area has emerged as a vibrant startup ecosystem in recent years, with a developing and supportive environment for early-stage companies, financed by seed stage capital with access to an extensive angel network and a talent pipeline fed by six world-class higher education institutions.


Glasgow, in particular, has grown an investment appetite around several industry clusters: advanced manufacturing, net zero, healthtech and precision medicine, the space economy, fintech and the digital & creative economy.

Several scaleups have emerged from Glasgow over the past decade, including <u>Smart Metering Systems</u>, <u>ENOUGH</u>, <u>HVS</u> (Hydrogen Vehicle Systems) and the Beeks Group.










Glasgow startups have raised £170M in the last year, which represents 8% investment growth on the year before.



Methodology & Appendix

Methodology & definitions

Startups & venture capital

This report focuses on companies in the internet age, i.e. after 2000. Most but not all unicorns are VC backed.

Companies included in the analysis are tech-driven. Industries include software, ecommerce, online marketplaces, hardware, ICT infrastructure. The full <u>industry & business</u> <u>model taxonomy</u> can be found online

Investment numbers refer to venture capital investment rounds such as seed, series A, B, C, late stage, and growth equity rounds. It excludes debt or other non-equity funding, lending capital, grants and ICOs.

Buyouts, M&A, secondary rounds, and IPOs are treated as exits: excluded from funding data, but included in exit data.

Underlying Data

Dealroom's proprietary database and software aggregate data from multiple sources: harvesting public information, user-submitted data verified by Dealroom, data engineering. All data is verified and curated with an extensive manual process.

Scope of the report

In this report, the local authorities that are considered as part of Glasgow City Region include: Glasgow City, North Lanarkshire, South Lanarkshire, East Dunbartonshire, West Dunbartonshire, Renfrewshire, East Renfrewshire, and Inverclyde.

While many startups founded in Glasgow City Region relocate beyond its borders, most maintain business-critical ties to their homelands. In order to take this reality into account, this report includes both Glasgow-based startups, which maintain their main center of business (HQ) in their country of origin, and Glasgow-founded startups, which relocated their HQ outside of Glasgow.
